INTRODUCTION

The Ramakrishna Mission is a widely acclaimed international spiritual organization having its headquarters at Belur Math, Howrah, West Bengal, India, was founded by Swami Vivekananda in May 1897. This was started as an instrument for disseminating the exalted spiritual teachings of Bhagavan Sri Ramakrishna. It goes without saying that those teachings of Sri Ramakrishna are founded on the rich cultural heritage of India. The Mission's goal is to translate its sublime ideals into practical reality for the elevation of humanity irrespective of caste, creed, religion and nationality. Vivekananda came for the good of the world and taught the world how to look upon people as the manifestation of the Divine.



BEGINNING OF THE SCHOOL

As per the request of the Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh, Ramakrishna Mission agreed to establish a new Secondary School on a hilltop at Lumdung. The construction work was started in 2018 and the project of construction of school buildings was almost completed in January, 2023. The long awaited Secondary School “Ramakrishna Mission Vidyapeeth, Lumdung”, Arunachal Pradesh was inaugurated in its new campus on 11th March, 2023 by Srimat Swami Gautamanandaji Maharaj, the then Vice President of Ramakrishna Math and Ramakrishna Mission, in presence of Shri Pema Khandu, Hon. Chief Minister, Arunachal Pradesh, Shri Kiren Rijiju, the then Hon. Minister, Law and Justice, Government of India, Sri Taba Tedir, the then Hon. Education Minister, Arunachal Pradesh and Shri Mama Natung, the then Hon. Minister, YA & S, WRD, Forest and Environment, Arunachal Pradesh with a hope of fulfilling Swami Vivekananda’s ideals of Education which basically teaches to serve Mankind only to serve God in a living form.



HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

In the end of June, 2017 the Nanghee Natung Mowa Tacha Welfare Society of Lumdung village, Dist. East Kameng, Arunachal Pradesh donated a piece of land to Ramakrishna Mission with an expectation that a Residential Secondary School should start at this place, so as to fulfil a long standing demand of the people of Arunachal Pradesh.

On 30th March, 2018 there was a meeting at Lumdung Govt Secondary School to discuss about the commencement of a Primary School for the time being. The Deputy Commissioner and DDSE of East Kameng were kind enough to provide some space to start up a Primary School on temporary basis to be run by the Ramakrishna Mission. Shri Mama Natung, Sri Shishu Natung, Dr. Tanie Natung, Er Suren Natung, Dr. Radhe Natung and others along with the District Administration had agreed wholeheartedly to support the noble project if taken up by the Mission. It was decided that Ramakrishna Mission Shishu Vidyamandir, Lumdung, a primary school for the students of Grade I and Grade II should start immediately in the month of September 2018.

CURRENT STATE OF AFFAIRS

Now the school is running upto Standard VIII and in the coming sessions it will be upgraded to the higher classes. The school has, at present, 235 students who are mostly local residents. Thus in 2018 the Ramakrishna Mission Shishu Vidyamandir, started its journey with 60 students was being operated till 2023 in the premises of eastwhile GSS, Lumdung, got shifted to its own campus and renamed as : “Ramakrishna Mission Vidyapeeth, Lumdung”. The school has got the State Recognition in 2024 and also CBSE affiliation in 2025 respectively.

ADMISSION

IMPORTANT POINTS TO NOTE:

- **Students may take admission to Class IV & V only through Admission Test to be held as per notification.**
- **Application Form for Admission must reach the Principal on or before the stipulated date.**
- **For grade IV- Age : Maximum age allowed 10 years or less .**
- **For grade V- Age : Maximum age allowed 11 years or less .**

A candidate with any kind of chronic disease is not allowed to take admission. Even after joining the school if a student is found to be unfit physically or having any harmful habit he/ she will be liable to be removed.

SCHOOL UNIFORM GROOMING

Students must attend the school in clean Uniform as prescribed above.

The attire must be descent and smart. Split Hair, Pony Tail, use of Hair Gel, any kind of Hair Dye are strictly prohibited. Tattoos are not allowed. Wearing chains, ear rings, bracelets, wrist watch etc are absolutely restricted. No students is allowed in the school with Mobile Phone or any kind of Electronic gadget whatsoever.



STAFF

Ramakrishna Mission Vidyapeeth is run under the leadership of a monastic Principal. He is assisted by efficient monastic and non-monastic staff members, teaching and non-teaching. At present the school has 18 faculty members whereas there are 5 non-teaching staffs.

EXAMINATION

Individual attention, as far as possible, is given to each student. Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) and periodical Unit Tests are conducted as usual.

For a student who is absent from any test, no provision can be made for supplementary test. Failure to appear any test or examination may seriously affect a student's promotion. Students failed in any subject or in Aggregate in Annual Examination will not be promoted to the next higher class in any circumstances, i.e. to pass all subjects is mandatory.

SESSION, VACATION AND HOLIDAYS

Presently the school session starts in April and ends in March next years. The school observes two vacations, viz : Puja Vacation, Christmas Vacation and Annual Vacation. A school calendar showing all the holidays and important events is circulated among the students at the beginning of the session.

FEES AND CHARGES

The parents/guardians will have to deposit Admission Fees, Session Charge, Tuition Fees etc. at Admin (Central) office as per notification at the time of admision. Students in the primary level are liable to enjoy Free Education.

ROUTINE

Normally the school starts at 9:00 a.m. with Vedic Chanting and National Anthem and ends at 1.15 p.m. unless otherwise specifically notified.

MDM

Every effort is made to provide the children with a wholesome and well balanced diet / tiffin during the recess period . The menu is decided as per the availability of items in the local markets in concurrence with provisions of Mid day Meal as pacified by DDSE.

MEDICAL FACILITIES AND HEALTH

As such there is no major Medical Facility in the School. But in case of some minor injury, or any ailment, subject to the gravity of the situation, the School has its own backup arrangement to relieve the patient. In case of serious crisis the patient is immediately send to the General Medical Hospital at Seppa by school transport.



DISCIPLINE

Discipline is a vital factor in every school. Needless to say that healthy, well-disciplined and morally strong children are the greatest assets of a nation. But the co-operation of guardians is essential to train up the children. Students, in the early stage, can be served more effectively by placing trust in and appealing to their sense of self-respect. In RKM Vidyapeeth students who have an aptitude for leadership get an opportunity to learn, to take up and carry out responsibilities in a fair and efficient manner. Respect to monastic members, to all the teachers and staff is an essential factor to maintain discipline. Sweet relation and mutual love between senior and junior students is another important factor for maintenance of discipline and tradition. Our students must be sobre, gentle and well-behaved.



EXTRA-CURRICULAR & CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

RKM Vidyapeeth provides ample provision for supplementary education in the form of various cultural activities viz. Music, Drawing, Recitation, Story Telling, Quiz Competition, Debate etc. Physical Training, Games and Sports are also organized for the students.

Wall magazines prepared by the students are displayed in the school notice board.



STUDENTS' STORE

The Students' Store is maintained for supplying essential commodities including Books and Dress to the Students whenever they need, on payment. A personal Store Deposit of Rs. 5000.00 is taken from every student and they can get their items of which the price is automatically deducted from the said deposit. Parents are requested to keep a minimum perpetual amount of Rs. 2000.00 (refundable) as store deposit for their ward.



TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS

Providing transportation facility for the new students is currently not available. If available, it is notified at the time of final selection. The provisions for transport, if any, are provided on basis of the merit of the case. A separate Application Form has to be submitted. Additionally, if needed the Parents/Guardians may arrange their own transport.



WITHDRAWALS

In case of withdrawal of a student or in case of removal by School Authority, only the Security Deposit will be refunded. The Security Money will be lapsed if the parents withdraw their ward in the middle of the session.

PAYMENT MODE

After the selection of the student a formal Fees Structure chart will be circulated.

Payment should be made either by cash or through Net Banking on specific Bank mentioned as per the instruction given on the notification sheet for Fees Structure.

IMPORTANT

In matters of dispute of any kind, the decision of the Secretary will be final and binding.

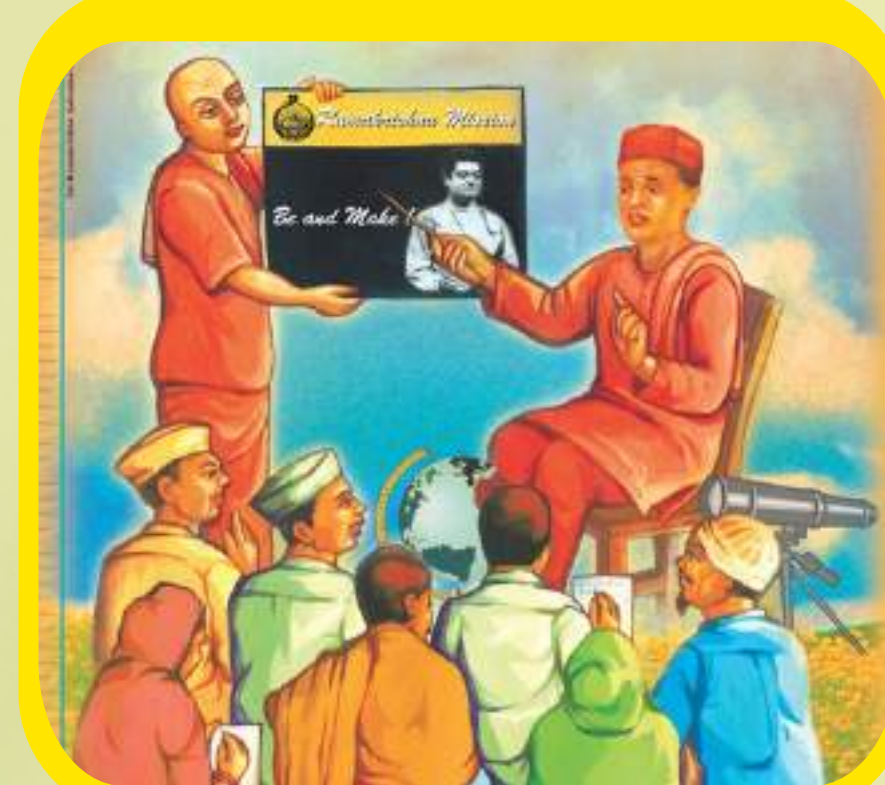
